COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

ORGANIZER:	ART SCHOOL OF JURMALA (<i>JŪRMALAS MĀKSLAS SKOLA</i>)
SUPPORTERS OF THE COMPETITION:	Jurmala City Council <i>Līvu Akvaparks (Livu</i> waterpark situated in Jurmala UNESCO LNC
AIM OF THE COMPETITION:	Using artistic expressions, encourage everyone's interest in a water eco system (water chain - springs, rivers, lakes, seas and oceans), its role in the development of human life, culture and traditions, as well as evaluate water as unifying element of cultures.
TASKS OF THE - COMPETITION: - - -	Encouraging children and youth for creative self-expression and motivating competition participants to express their individuality and artistic imagination in visual art. Stimulate children's and youth's interest in the environment and their national culture and traditions. Giving children and youth a possibility to get to know nature, culture and traditions of other countries. Creating an opportunity to exchange experience among children, youth and teachers, and giving them a possibility to make new friends, find new cooperation partners and create new ideas.
THEME OF THE COMPETITION:	THE STORM
PARTICIPANTS: -	Children and youth of age from 4 to 25; Works can be submitted by educational institutions, public organizations and individuals.
AUTHOR OF THE WORK:	AN INDIVIDUAL
ARTWORK DIMENSIONS: -	Only originals will be accepted; Work copies (Xerox, electronic etc.) will not be evaluated; Participants shall submit two-dimensional works; Work dimensions - A3 format (30 × 42 cm) or A2 format (42 × 60 cm); Silk screen press works can be A4 format (21 x 29, 7 cm); Computer graphics works and photos will be accepted only in JPG standard. Edges of the work should not be less than 1000 pixels; The artworks are not be framed except artworks of category "Textile" Frame of the artwork of category "Textile" should be thin and light.
NUMBER OF WORKS: -	An individual may submit a maximum of 2 (two) works; Educational institutions per class may submit no more than 4 (four) works from each age category and technique category.

EVALUATION OF WORKS:

AGE CATEGORY: 4-7 year old; 8-11 year old; 12 – 15 year old; 16 – 25 year old. Computer graphics works and photos are evaluated in 2 age categories: 8 - 15 year old; 16 – 25 year old. Paintings (Gouache, acrylic, tempera, watercolour, oil colour, oil **TECHNIQUE CATEGORY:** crayons, mixed techniques); Graphics (Silk screen press, pencil, colour pencils, Indian ink, charcoal, sepia, sangin, gel pens, markers); Computer graphics and photography; Textiles – (presentation thin, light). _ **EVALUATION CRITERIA:** Work adequacy to the competition theme; _ The author's creative idea: High level artistic performance. IN ADDITION:: Works made by children and youth with special needs are evaluated in the separate category. JURY: International jury has been approved by the organizers of the competition. Jury consists of professional artists. The jury reserves the rights: To change the prize distribution by category. Not to evaluate a work of the competition, which does not comply with the theme or terms of competition. Not to award any medal. To award a number of first, second or third place. To award special prizes for a particular performance. PRIZES: Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded for each technique and age category. Grand Prix will be awarded for each technique category and one age category 8 – 25 year old. Jury will also award incentive prizes, acknowledgments and diplomas for successful themes revelation and artistic performances. In addition to the international jury, works may be evaluated by other Latvian organizations, the children's jury may also be set up.


